### Drawing and Painting class

With one on one guidance, students will develop their skills in drawing and painting. They will have an opportunity to explore acrylic, oils and watercolor. Students are responsible for their own materials. A material list can be provided. Beginners and intermediate students welcome.

- Class meets on Wednesdays. Start date is June 20. Last day of class is August 1. (no class July 2-6)

## Adults

### Introduction to Wheel Throwing Class



This class includes an introduction to the potter's wheel, focusing on wedging, shaping, trimming, simple glazing techniques, and studio safety. Typically, students take this class more than once before they are comfortable moving on to the next level. We have designed the beginning pottery classes to give you the basic skills and knowledge (after a couple of sessions) to

become an open studio member.

- Cost: \$170 for eight weeks
- Class meets on Thursdays. Start date is June 21. Last day of class is August 16. (no class July 2-6)
- Time: 6 to 9 pm

### Intermediate Wheel Throwing

• This course is offered to for students who have been taking beginners wheel throwing and want to develop their skills to the next level at wheel throwing. Students will continue to throw pots, bowls, vases, cups, and plates. .

- Cost: \$160 for eight weeks
- Class meets on Tuesdays. Start date is June 19. Last day of class is August 11. (no class July 2-6)
- Time: 6 to 9 pm

## Adults

### Clay Tile Making

In this course students will learn to create handmade tiles using a variety of methods including slabs, press molds, and bisque stamps. Emphasis will be placed creating textural surfaces and bas-relief designs with clay.



- Beginners are welcome as well as students with clay experience.
- Cost: \$140 for six weeks
- Time: 6:30 to 8:30 pm
