Clay - Wheel Throwing or Hand building

We offer wheel throwing or hand building clay parties. Participants build their own art object from wet clay and have an option of finishing it with glaze. The wet clay takes approximately one week to dry and needs to be fired prior to glazing. After the first firing, studio staff will glaze the work in the chosen glaze and it will be fired again. Art work can be picked up 2 - 3 weeks after your event. We offer to glaze your pieces in the following colors: speckle white, satin black, green, or clear.

Party time is included for you to enjoy the refreshments you bring or have delivered to the studio. (We have lots of great local businesses in downtown Rochester who deliver!). We provide space for you to set up your food and party goods. We do not provide food, beverages or paper goods.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW:

For Girl Scouts or Boy Scouts, the prices are based on groups for three hours, where we can alternate showing the troops on how to wheel throw and hand build. If there is a particular clay project that the troop wants to learn to help them earn their badge, let us know!

Cost:

For groups of 6 to 10: \$15 per person for three hours, plus \$20 set up and clean up fee.

For groups of 11 or more: \$18 per person for three hours, plus \$20 set up and clean up fee. (Our maximum is 15).

* A non-refundable deposit of \$25 is required to reserve your group date. Payment is due at the start of the event.

* troop leaders are welcome to join in!

Time: Tuesday or Friday evenings are available and Saturday afternoons. Evening times are 6 to 9 pm. Afternoon is from 12:30 to 3:30 pm. Please send at least one months notice.

Troop leader is responsible for picking up the finished pieces. We will fire and glaze them using the following colors: clear, speckle white, satin black and green.
